Coral came into the HBSPCA as a stray; usually people think of cats, sometimes dogs, as stray; but a rabbit? Surprisingly, the HBSPCA gets a lot of small critters that have been abandoned or dumped somewhere – animals picked up from various urban areas that don't normally live alone in the outdoors. Stray rabbits, stray guinea pigs, stray rats .... These animals were all someone's pet at some point and when they come to the shelter, they get a second chance at finding a forever home. Coral is a Netherland Dwarf breed; she's small and exotic, especially with her butter-scotch colouring. Upon arrival, shelter staff learned she was tame, friendly and litter-trained but a little nervous being displaced with so many unfamiliar faces, smells, sights and sounds. Coral was brought to the shelter with two other rabbits and



two cats as part of a multi-intake from a partner rescue organization and was adopted to her happy forever family from HBSPCA satellite adoptions centre at PetSmart Ancaster. Coral is one of the lucky ones: her shelter stay was short (less than 10 days), she was picked up uninjured and her spay surgery was quick and easy too. And now that she's in a loving, attentive home she has plenty of time for snuggles, adventures around the house and munching on her favourite greens – well done Coral!
