Luna came to the Hamilton/Burlington SPCA (HBSPCA) shelter this spring from a partner rescue. Already missing many of her teeth, what remained were badly damaged and needed to be removed... leading to her very distinctive and goofy look. Stinky breath and a mouthful of damaged teeth were the least of Luna’s health woes. She was born with a condition called Hemivertebra, meaning the bones in her spine are misshaped, causing her wobbly walk.

But a silly tongue and a wobbly walk don’t slow this beauty down – Luna can run circles around her canine friends and was adopted by a family eager to give this special needs pooch a second chance.

Where does a happy, wobbly girl find herself on a Sunday morning in September? At the HBSPCA’s Wiggle Waggle Walk, of course! Luna is a perfect example of how funds raised at events like this are used – no matter how smelly the mouth, no matter how stumbly the walk, no matter what it takes to rehabilitate an animal in need, all will find a loving forever home.
