Just before turning four, Kaeko was hit by a car and her owners couldn't afford the costly treatments needed for her medical care. Kaeko came to us through our Protections Team and was immediately assessed at the Companion Animal Hospital. It was quickly determined her leg would have to be amputated; the car accident injured her so badly the bone was protruding from the wound and there was no alternative to amputation. After surgery, this beautiful Siberian husky mix went into foster care for recovery with a dedicated volunteer, who later adopted her. Kaeko is the fourth dog this hero has adopted from the shelter AND he helps at the hospital, at events, at rabies/microchip clinics, and as a foster caregiver. Who better than to provide a safe, loving home for a dog who survived such a traumatic, life-altering event. Kaeko needed a bit of extra time and attention while adjusting to the loss of her limb but her caring, patient forever family has helped this sweet girl overcome any challenge put in her path. With lots of love to offer her new family, she is an active, well-exercised girl who loves going on outdoor adventures and playing tug-of-war and fetch all the time.
