Honey Bee was surrendered to our care at just one week old, with eyes barely open and not able to eat or drink on her own. She had a broken leg and needed surgery right away; her hind leg was too damaged and had to be amputated. For the first few weeks of her foster care, Honey Bee had to be bottle fed and closely monitored – being separated from her mom was seriously threatening her health. She also had worms; she was treated for those too. And by the time she was ready to be spayed, it was clear that her front legs were deformed from birth, causing long-term mobility issues. Soon, this little champion would teach herself how to get around, with the help of her dedicated foster mom (who happened to be a vet AND her forever adopter – foster fail strikes again!) and some unconventional exercise and training methods (she army crawls! she does water aerobics and weight training! she might try a prosthetic leg!)
